## HONORARY PARADE MARSHAL 2024



### COMMISSIONER ROBERT TRACY

Robert J. Tracy joined the Saint Louis Metropolitan Police Department as Police Commissioner on January 6, 2023. He has more than 40 years of law enforcement experience, including service with the New York Police Department, Chicago Police Department, and the Wilmington (Delaware) Department of Police.

While serving with the New York Police Department, Chief Tracy was the commander of the Firearms and Suppression Division. He also served as the Commander of the Firearms Investigation Unit and led the Violent Felony Squad.

In Chicago, Chief Tracy worked as Crime Control Strategist, implementing programs that led to a significant decrease in gang related violent crime. The strategies deployed by Chief Tracy resulted in Chicago's lowest murder rate in 50 years, and a 37% reduction in overall crime during a 5-year period.

As the Chief of Police in Wilmington, Delaware, Chief Tracy continued implementing Best Practice Strategies, and that City also saw historic reductions in violent crime, including shootings and murders.

In St. Louis, Chief Tracy is working to implement the same proven strategies that have brought about positive results in his past cities, both large and small.

Chief Tracy has also served in the private sector, as Vice President of Security for Summit Security Services, and Vice President/Global Crisis Response Manager in the Office of Business Continuity for CitiGroup.

Chief Tracy holds a Master's in Public Administration and a Bachelor of Arts in History. He is the recipient of many distinguished awards, including the Police Foundation Dale Hummerdinger award, among numerous others. Chief Tracy and his wife Brenda have five children and are thrilled to have made St. Louis their new home.

**MINISTER PATRICK O'DONOVAN**

Patrick O'Donovan is Minister of State at the Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts, Gaeltacht, Sport and Media with special responsibility for the Gaeltacht. He is also Minister of State at the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform with special responsibility for the Office of Public Works.

He previously served as Minister of State at the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform with special responsibility for Public Procurement, Open Government, and eGovernment, a role to which he was appointed in June 2017. Prior to this, he was Minister of State for Tourism and Sport, from 2016 to 2017.

He was elected to Dáil Éireann in 2011 for the Limerick County Constituency, and prior to his election to the Dáil, served as a member of Limerick County Council from 2003-2011.

He has served as a member of the Dáil Public Accounts Committee, the Oireachtas Committees on Transport, Communications and Natural Resources and Public Services Oversight and Petitions. He was also a member of the British Irish Parliamentary Assembly.

Patrick worked as an Analytical Chemist, Health, Safety and Environment manager, industry consultant and primary teacher prior to his election to the Dáil.

He is married to Eileen and they have 3 children together.

Prior to becoming the 33rd US Army Chief of Chemical and Commandant of the US Army CBRN School, COL Bochat was the Chief of Staff, 2nd Infantry ROK-US Combined Division, Camp Humphreys, Korea.

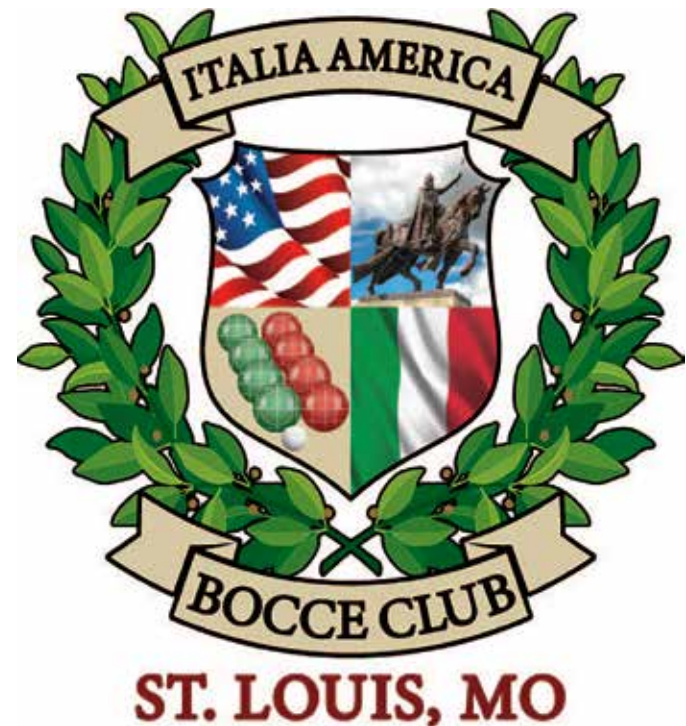

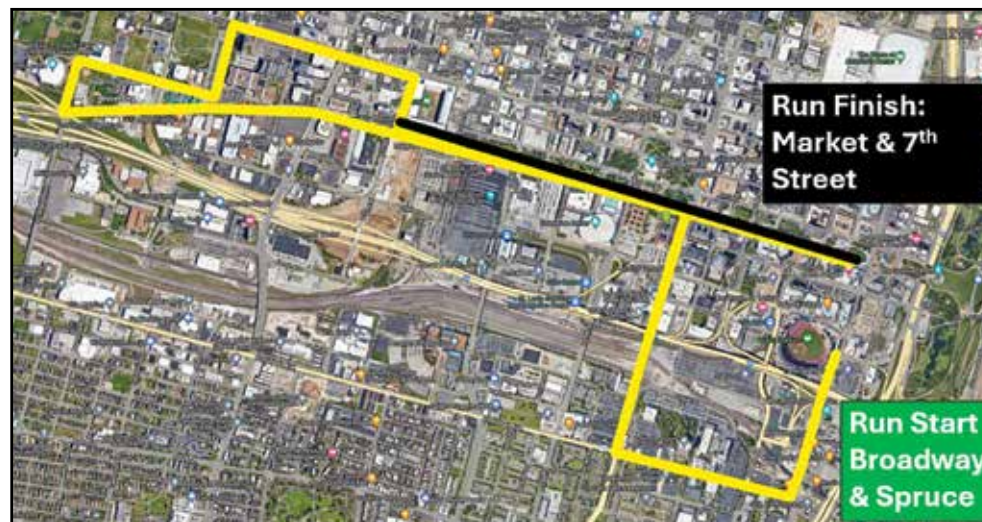

## ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE IN ST. LOUIS CELEBRATES 54 YEARS OF THE WEARIN' OF THE GREEN

On a blustery March day in 1970 Joseph B. McGlynn, Jr., the founder of the St. Patrick's Day Parade in St. Louis, Mayor Alphonso Cervantes, Patrick Walsh, Irish Consul General – Chicago; and an intrepid band of marchers and floats depicting Irish heritage slogged through green-tinted snow on Olive Street downtown in the first St. Patrick's Day parade of the 20th century. McGlynn and the Notre Dame Club of St. Louis put on that first parade. Now, 54 years later and in the 21st century the tradition also known as the Rite of Spring is the centerpiece of the area's St. Patrick's Day celebrations and is still going strong.

Joe McGlynn, now 90 years young, and St. Louis' Retired Honorary Irish Consul, is still a driving force behind St. Louis' most popular and well-attended parade (in good weather over 350,000 crowd the parade route) but now instead of just the Notre Dame Club of St. Louis, he's aided by a committee of nearly 120 claiming Irish heritage and a marshal corps of over 190 volunteers who actually stage the parade. To that must be added a detail of nearly 120 St. Louis police officers, city officials, official sponsors of the parade, media partners, honorary parade marshals, the Irish government, which provides a representative for nearly every parade and others.

Over the years a who's who of Irish elected officials has found their way to St. Louis for the St. Patrick's Day Parade. An honor that no other American city of our size enjoys. The list includes: Prime Minister Jack Lynch, who attended the second parade in 1971; Bertie Ahern, former Prime Minister and Member of Parliament; Erskine Childers, Deputy Prime Minister and Member of Parliament; Marie Geoghegan-Quinn, Minister of the Department of the Taoiseach and Member of Parliament; Ben Briscoe, Lord Mayor of Dublin and Member of Parliament; John Bruton, leader of the Fine Gael Party; John Hume, leader of SDLP, M.P. and M.E.P. in Northern Ireland; Mark Durkan, Deputy First Minister of Northern Ireland; and many more.

The list of Honorary Parade Marshals includes St. Louisans Denny Long, president of Anheuser Busch and Michael Roarty, executive vice president of Anheuser Busch; Most Reverend Edward O'Donnell, auxiliary Bishop of St. Louis; Charles Gallagher, Sr., chairman of United Fruit and Produce;

Michael Shanahan, Sr., president of Engineered Systems; Jack Buck, member of the Sportscasters Hall of Fame; Most Reverend Justin Rigali, Archbishop of St. Louis; Patrick Finneran, Jr., vice president and general manager, Boeing Integrated Defense Systems; Charles Drury, Chairman of Drury Development Corporation; Robert O'Loughlin, founder and chairman of Lodging Hospitality Management Company, John Saunders, president of FleishmanHillard and Kevin Short, CEO of Clayton Capital Partners, Fire Chief Dennis Jenkerson, Patrick Murphy and other distinguished St. Louisans.

In 1978 the St. Patrick's Day Run in St. Louis was added to parade day and precedes the parade on Saturday morning. The five mile/3K run has since become the largest locally organized run in St. Louis. Over 5,000 runners participated in 2019 Michelob ULTRA St. Patrick's Day Parade Run. "From the very first run 44 years ago, Anheuser Busch was there supporting our efforts to stage the run as well as the parade," notes McGlynn. "This year, Michelob ULTRA will again sponsor the run."

As the year's passed the parade and its spectator base became too large for Olive Street and it and the run were moved to Market Street where it now steps off at 20th and Market (Union Station) marching east to Broadway and concludes at Kiener Plaza where the Irish Village and Runners Village are located. When the weather is good, more than 350,000 spectators line the parade route to watch the elaborate floats, marching bands, marching units, dance groups, animal units, novelty groups, motorized organizations, and large helium-filled cartoon character balloons.

"We're a little like the Pied Piper, hopefully bringing people into downtown to enjoy the post parade activities, such as the Irish Village, BallPark Village and the post-parade party at the Hilton St. Louis at the Ballpark," adds McGlynn.

After 55 years, one can safely say that the St. Patrick's Day Parade and Run in St. Louis and their attendant parties and activities have become part of the fabric of the community and much anticipated events for those of Irish heritage and those that are Irish for the day or weekend. It's a "rite" that will be right for St. Louis for another 55 years.

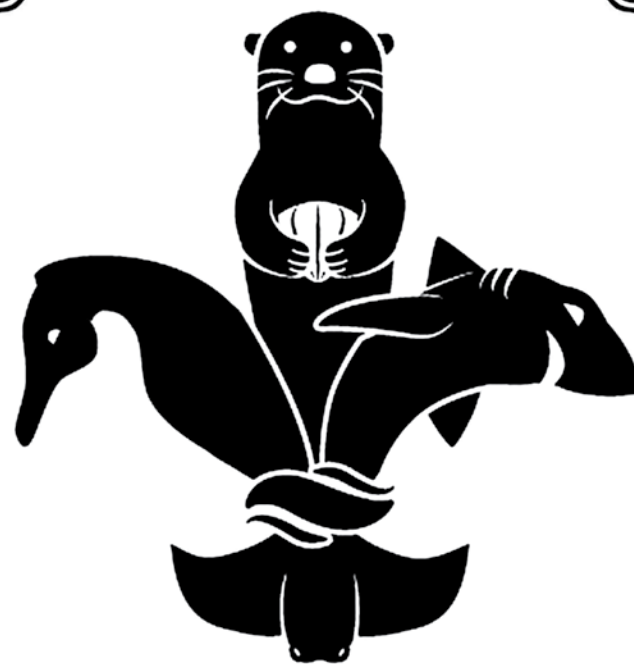
