



Eamonn Wall

Eamonn Wall is a native of Enniscorthy, Co. Wexford, who has lived in St. Louis since 2000. He is employed as the Smurfit-Stone Corporation Professor of Irish Studies at the University of Missouri-St. Louis where he is also a Professor of English. He received degrees from University College, Dublin; the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee; and a Ph.D. in English from the City University of New York-Graduate Center.

At UMSL, Eamonn curates the monthly Irish Lectures, Readings and Concerts Series for UMSL Global, is the director of UMSL's annual summer study abroad program at the University of Galway and teaches classes that focus on Irish writing and culture.

Eamonn Wall is the author of eleven books including My Aunts at Twilight Poker (2023), From Oven Lane to Sun Prairie: In Search of Irish America (2019); Writing the Irish West: Ecologies and Traditions (2011). He has published essays, articles, and reviews in many publications including The Irish Times, The Washington Post, Chicago Tribune, Reading Ireland, New Hibernia Review, Prairie Schooner, and other publications.

Eamonn has received many honors for his writing and community service including the Durkan Prize from the American Conference for Irish Studies for excellence in scholarship; the *Irish Echo* Award for distinguished service to Irish Arts and Culture in North America; and an award for distinguished community service to St. Louis and Missouri from the Mayor of St. Louis. He is past-president of the American Conference for Irish Studies, the first Irish-born academic elected to this position.

Married to Drucilla Wall and the parents of two children, and grandparents of a girl and two boys, his family lives in Webster Groves.

Senator Shane Curley

Senator Shane Curley was raised in Raheen, a small rural townland near Loughrea town in County Galway.

He grew up with a love for the native Irish sport of hurling – winning the Galway County Final with Kilnadeema National School in 2003, and going on to win national finals with St. Brigid's College in 2006, 2007 and 2009. He has played traditional Irish music since he was 7 years of age.

Shane went to university to study to be a teacher, and graduated from Trinity College Dublin in 2016. He taught Irish and French for 2 years in Dublin before returning home to Galway to teach in Athenry.

He always had a keen interest in politics growing up, mainly as his father was active with the local Fianna Fáil party. In 2018, he successfully ran for Vice President of Ógra Fianna Fáil – the youth wing of his party. The following year, he ran in the 2019 local elections and was elected as a Councillor to Galway County Council at the age of 28.

In 2025, Shane ran for the Senate elections in Ireland and was elected at the age of 34. He is the youngest senator in the Fianna Fáil party. His main priorities are reforming local government and education, particularly the reform of second level education in Ireland.





ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE IN ST. LOUIS CELEBRATES 56 YEARS OF THE WEARIN' OF THE GREEN

On a blustery March day in 1970, Joseph B. McGlynn, Jr., the founder of the St. Patrick's Day Parade in St. Louis; Mayor Alphonso Cervantes; Patrick Walsh, Irish Consul General – Chicago; and an intrepid band of marchers and floats depicting Irish heritage slogged through green-tinted snow on Olive Street downtown in the first St. Patrick's Day parade of the 20th century. McGlynn and the Notre Dame Club of St. Louis put on that first parade. Now, 55 years later and in the 21st century the tradition also known as the First Rite of Spring is the centerpiece of the area's St. Patrick's Day celebrations and is still going strong.

Joe McGlynn, now 91 years young, and St. Louis' Honorary Irish Consul Emeritus, is still a driving force behind St. Louis' most popular and well-attended parade (in good weather over 350,000 crowd the parade route), but now instead of just the Notre Dame Club of St. Louis, he's aided by a committee of nearly 120 claiming Irish heritage and a marshal corps of over 190 volunteers who actually stage the parade. To that must be added a detail of nearly 120 St. Louis police officers, city officials, official sponsors of the parade, media partners, honorary parade marshals, the Irish government – which has sent an official representative for nearly every parade – and others.

Over the years a who's who of Irish elected officials has found their way to St. Louis for the St. Patrick's Day Parade, an honor that no other American city of our size enjoys. The list includes: Prime Minister Jack Lynch, who attended the second parade in 1971; Bertie Ahern, former Prime Minister and Member of Parliament; Erskine Childers, Deputy Prime Minister and Member of Parliament; Marie Geoghegan-Quinn, Minister of the Department of the Taoiseach and Member of Parliament; Ben Briscoe, Lord Mayor of Dublin and Member of Parliament; John Bruton, leader of the Fine Gael Party; John Hume, leader of SDLP, M.P. and M.E.P. in Northern Ireland; Mark Durkan, Deputy First Minister of Northern Ireland; and many more.

The list of Honorary Parade Marshals includes St. Louisans Denny Long, president of Anheuser Busch and Michael Roarty, executive vice president of Anheuser Busch; Most Reverend Edward O'Donnell, auxiliary Bishop of St. Louis; Charles Gallagher, Sr., chairman of United Fruit and Produce; Michael Shanahan, Sr., president of Engineered Systems; Jack Buck, member of the Sportscasters Hall of

Fame; Most Reverend Justin Rigali, Archbishop of St. Louis; Patrick Finneran, Jr., vice president and general manager, Boeing Integrated Defense Systems; Charles Drury, Chairman of Drury Development Corporation; Robert O'Loughlin, founder and chairman of Lodging Hospitality Management Company; John Saunders, president of FleishmanHillard; Kevin Short, CEO of Clayton Capital Partners; Fire Chief Dennis Jenkerson; television producer Patrick Murphy; and other distinguished St. Louisans.

In 1978, the St. Patrick's Day Run in St. Louis was added to parade day and precedes the parade on Saturday morning. The five mile/3K run has since become the largest locally organized run in St. Louis.

"From the very first run 47 years ago, Anheuser Busch was there supporting our efforts to stage the run as well as the parade," notes McGlynn. "This year, Michelob ULTRA will again sponsor the run."

As the year's passed, the parade and its spectator base became too large for Olive Street and it and the run were moved to Market Street where, it now steps off at 10th and Market marching west to 20th Street and concludes at Union Station. When the weather is good, more than 350,000 spectators line the parade route to watch the elaborate floats, marching bands, marching units, dance groups, animal units, novelty groups, motorized organizations, and large helium-filled cartoon character balloons.

"We're a little like the Pied Piper, hopefully bringing people into downtown to enjoy the post parade activities, such as the Irish Village, BallPark Village and the post-parade party at the Hilton St. Louis at the Ballpark," adds McGlynn.

After 55 years, one can safely say that the St. Patrick's Day Parade and Run in St. Louis and their attendant parties and activities have become part of the fabric of the community. They are much anticipated events for those of Irish heritage and those that are Irish for the day or weekend. It's a "rite" that will be right for St. Louis for another 55 years.

Continuing St. Louis Irish Connections

St. Louis' ties and parallels to Ireland are many. Our histories and current connections form the fabric of our town's Irish American experience. Represented on the program cover is a visual example of an ongoing project that keeps these ties strong.

The midlands of both the U.S. and Ireland, specifically St. Louis, MO and Roscommon, Ireland share common medieval development. Located along their respective country's longest river system, both grew into centers for commerce and societal significance. Although the medieval heyday of the Mississippian mounds in and around St. Louis and the MacDermot lords' Rock of Lough Key castle in Roscommon County lay beneath the soil, a connection between the two is alive and flourishing.

St. Louis University Department of History Professor Thomas Finan spearheaded a team of Irish and American archeologists that began in 2004 with geophysical and aerial survey, followed with multiple excavations at sites around Lough Key, and culminating in highly successful excavations on the Rock 2019-2023.

Thanks to a Fulbright Specialist Award, Finan will continue his work with colleagues at the University of Galway to create a joint database of archaeological and historical research focusing on Gaelic Ireland. Work begins this summer in Galway with the completion of a fully implemented database expected by November 2025.


